Literacy

This term, we are going to be fully immersed in 'The Jungle Book' as our class book. We will use lots of drama and imagination to write a range of descriptive setting, narratives between the characters. We will also look at letter writing and instructions in depth to link to our science and geography learning from over the term.

Numeracy

The four operations and new written strategies will be introduced. We will also look at place value. We would kindly ask that your child continues to develop their mental maths skills by practising their times tables (this can be accessed via times tables rockstars).

Science

Two areas of the science curriculum will be covered over the term. We will be looking at the habitats, diet and life cycles of animals including that of humans. We will also be exploring plant, their life cycle and function.

ICT/ Computing

New programs will be introduced in ICT now that the children are confident in logging on to their own account. We will introduce them to Logo activities where they can programme a moving object. iPads and photoshop will also be used to look at photo editing and design.

Design Technology/ Art

In our STEM/DT Project we aim to create some bird homes to place in our local areas. We are hoping to use recyclable materials to create this. We then aim to design, create and evaluate the end product.

Music

We will be using the continuation of the Ukulele to learn a range of songs. We would also like to branch our music learning into other curriculum areas such as PE through some work on Carnival of the Animals.

RE

Our studies in Religious Education will be based around the Hindu faith this term.
