Key Knowledge

The **Elizabethan Age** was the period when **Queen Elizabeth I** was in power. This time saw a lot of **new things**, including the full flowering of English literature and poetry. There were many **more theatres**, including one with William Shakespeare, who wrote plays. There were **religious changes**, with some people becoming Protestants after the Church split apart. The **Spanish Armada** was a fleet of ships that Spain sent to attack England in 1588. It was commanded by the Duke of Medina Sidonia, an aristocrat without previous naval experience appointed by Philip II of Spain. The Armada's failure made Spain less powerful in Europe. It also changed the way sea battles were fought.

Timeline - key dates

1558 - Elizabeth I becomes Queen of England,
1568 - Mary Queen of Scots is imprisoned for 18 years
1576 - The first purpose built theatre is opened
1577- 80 - Francis Drake's voyage
1580s - Shakespeare begins writing plays
1585 - War with Spain
1588 - Spanish Armada is defeated
1599 - Globe Theatre opens
1601 - The "poor law" is passed to help poverty in England
1603 - Elizabeth I dies - James VI ascends to the throne
1616 - William Shakespeare dies

Spanish Armada - A Spanish fleet (group of ships) that sailed from Lisbon in late May 1588.
Monarchy - A monarchy is a form of government that has a single person known as a monarch at its head. Monarchs use such titles as king and queen.
